

# FAFSA Simplification

## Highlights of FAFSA Changes

- FAFSA and CADAA Application No longer Oct. 1st -> **NEW DATE: To be Determined in December 2023**
- The Student Aid Index (**SAI**) will replace the Expected Family Contribution (**EFC**).
- The parent with the most **financial support** in the last calendar year must complete the form.
- Students and contributors will need an **FSA ID** to submit the FAFSA.
- The new FAFSA process will consider the **cost of attendance** and the **new SAI** when determining **financial need**.

## What can the Student do now?

- Collect the same **documentation** that they need for the FAFSA every year, including **tax forms** for 2022.
- If they have an **FSA ID**, confirm that they can access the account. If not, **create** one.
- Obtain an **ITIN** and/or **invite** a Parent/Spouse to Obtain one.
